# TRANSURETHRAL VS INTRACAV ADMINISTRATION OF ALPROST

Transurethral administration has fewer side effects than intracavernous administration of alprostadil.

Both intracavernous and transurethral administration lead to increased blood flow to the penis.

The dosage of transurethral alprostadil ranges from 1 to 10 mcg, which is higher than the dose required for intracavernous administration.

Erection develops 5 to 10 minutes after drug injection and lasts 30 to 60 minutes.
