1. What methods can you use to connect with a librarian?

6. What does each letter of the CRAAP mnemonic represent (Ashman et al., 2021)? **Currency: is the information the most up-to-date? When was this published? Relevance: is the information relatable to the topic or answer the question? Authority: is the author of the source an expert on the topic? .gov or .org Accuracy: is the information of the source accurate and supported through evidence? Peer-reviewed?**

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
