

**iHuman: Week 5 Deborah Arnaudin: Abdominal pain vomiting and constipation for 2 days**

Visual well groomed

HPI:

- **Onset:** "When did this start?" abdominal pain started two days ago after dinner
- **Location:** "Where did the problem start; does it move anywhere?" around the umbilicus
- **Duration:** "How long does the problem last, or is it constant?" comes and goes in waves; when it comes, it lasts for several minutes but then slowly goes away.
- **Characteristics:** "Can you describe what the problem feels like?" she states it started like cramping but now feels like someone is squeezing her stomach from the inside; she complains of abdominal bloating for the past two days, and the pain lasts for several minutes comes and goes in waves. She has never had a pain like this before. Pain does not radiate.
- **Aggravating Factors:** "Does anything make it worse?" It hurts more when pushing on the abdomen, getting full quickly
- **Relieving Factors:** "Does anything make it better?" after vomiting,
- **Treatments:** "Have you taken any medications or nonpharmaceutical treatments for this problem?" did not do any treatments yet.
- **The severity of the Symptoms:** "How bothersome is this problem?" 8-9 of 10

Two days ago, she also started having watery bowel movements, which are not typical for her. Also, she has complaints of nausea and vomiting of bright greenish liquid.

ROS:

General: denies generalized weakness and fever.

GI: Abdominal pain, vomiting, constipation (-sensation of incomplete bowel emptying; did not usually have constipation until two days ago; it has been days since she passed gas, -greasy foul smell stools, black-tar-like or foul-smelling stool, blood in stool
