Please read the assignment guidelines and rubric and answer the following questions based on observations of the volunteer in your recorded psychiatric interview submitted in Week 4.

1) Mental Status Examination: View the recorded psychiatric interview submitted in Week 4 and observe the mental status of your volunteer. Use appropriate terminology to document your observations of the mental status exam (MSE) components below.

Appearance	Pt appeared at their stated age and was appropriately dressed for the sitting. Grooming and hygiene were adequate. Posture was relaxed, and no abnormal movements, tremors or involuntary behaviors were observed
Behavior and attitude	The patient was cooperative and engaged throughout the interview. Eye contact was appropriate. Psychomotor activity was within the normal limits, with no evidence of agitation or psychomotor retardation.
Speech	The speech was spontaneous, fluent, and coherent. Rate, volume, and tone were within normal limits. No pressured, slowed, or slurred speech was noted just stutter at times.
