SUMMARIZE

Using a patient seen in the practicum setting, summarize the H&P into an organized and concise format.

CC	A 63-year-old female patient presents with complaints of severe low back pain in the right sacroiliac area, which started four days ago. She reports no prior history of trauma or exertion. The patient took two 400 mg tablets of Advil, but they did not provide any relief.
HPI statement using OLDCARTS data	The patient woke up on 09/08/2024 with severe low back pain, which she describes as non-radiating. She denies any recent physical exertion or trauma. There are no accompanying symptoms of urinary frequency, hematuria, or abdominal discomfort. She reports a history of breast cancer (left invasive ductal carcinoma), which was treated with lumpectomy and chemotherapy in 2014. She has a history of hypothyroidism, hyperlipidemia, and osteopenia.
Pertinent ROS	• General: Denies fever, weight loss, or recent illness. • Musculoskeletal: Reports severe low back pain but no joint swelling or muscle weakness. • Neurologic: Denies any numbness, tingling, or bowel/bladder incontinence.
Pertinent PE	• Vitals: Normal. • Musculoskeletal: Tenderness to palpation over the right sacroiliac joint. No redness, swelling, or deformity. Range of motion is limited due to pain. • Neurological: Normal motor and sensory function in the lower extremities.
