Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia

- Management of Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia/Low
- Benign prostatic hyperplasia is caused by proliferation of prostatic transitional epithelial cells
- Lower Urinary Tract Symptoms
- Hyperplasia - increased number of cells (et al., 2021)
