3. License requirements in the state where you intend to practice:
 - a. What are the licensure requirements to become a nurse practitioner? The requirements encompass a registered nurse license, a graduate degree in a nurse practitioner role and national certification. Licensure requirements (Georgia Nurse Practice Act, 2025) to practice as a psychiatric/mental health nurse practitioner must submit the following:
 1. Evidence of current licensure as a registered professional nurse in the state of Georgia;
 2. A completed board application with a required fee;
 3. An official transcript that verifies a master's or higher degree in nursing with specialization in psychiatric/mental health nursing which includes a minimum of two graduate courses in psychiatric/mental health nursing, supervised practice for each of the two graduate courses, and evidence of advanced pharmacology within the curriculum or as a separate course; and
 4. Verification of current national certification as a clinical nurse specialist in psychiatric/mental health from the American Nurses Credentialing Center.



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
