The ICS impacts client care outcomes by providing limited resources where they are needed the most, which improves the quality and timeliness of care. The ICS impacts staff safety by assigning clear roles and responsibilities which reduces confusion and leads to safer environments for staff. The ICS also ensures that members from different teams can seamlessly work together, decreasing chaos and dangerous situations.
