- **Assigned Primary Diagnosis:** Peripheral Neuropathy
- **Client Name:** Bo Sampson
- **Date of Birth:** 7/15/60
- **Chief Complaint:** Tingling, burning pain and numbness in feet and lower legs
- **History of Present Illness:** This is a 65 y/o male presenting with burning, tingling, and numbness in his feet and lower legs that has been worsening over the last few months. He has a history of diabetes, hypertension, and hyperlipidemia. He is compliant with all medications.
- **Physical Exam**
 - **Height:** 6' 1"
 - **Weight:** 180lbs
 - **BMI:** 23.7
 - **Blood pressure:** 124/72
 - **Heart rate:** 64
 - **Respiratory rate:** 15
 - **Oxygen saturation:** 97% RA
 - **Temperature:** 98.7
- **Past Medical History (PMH) (Include at least three significant pieces of the client's past medical history)**
 - Diabetes Mellitus type 2
 - Hypertension
 - Hyperlipidemia
