Domains Needing Additional Study

Based on the results of the Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) Prediagnostic Assessment completed in Week 4, two American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) domains identified as areas needing additional study are Psychopharmacology (66.67%) and Assessment S Advanced Practice (70.00%). Both scores fall below the recommended threshold of 80%, highlighting the need for additional review and practice in these foundational areas (Clinical Education Associates, 2025).

Study Strategies for Improvement

To enhance understanding and performance in these two domains, the following study strategies will be implemented:

1. Targeted Remediation Modules

I will complete the remediation modules through Skills on Point, which include structured lessons and quizzes designed to reinforce key pharmacologic and assessment concepts. This structured, competency-based approach helps target weak areas systematically (Clinical Education Associates, 2025).

2. Case-Based Learning and Practice Questions

Using case-based practice questions from Stahl's Essential Psychopharmacology and Fitzgerald PMHNP Review, I will apply theoretical knowledge to clinical decision-making scenarios. This strategy strengthens diagnostic reasoning and medication management skills (Stahl, 2021).
