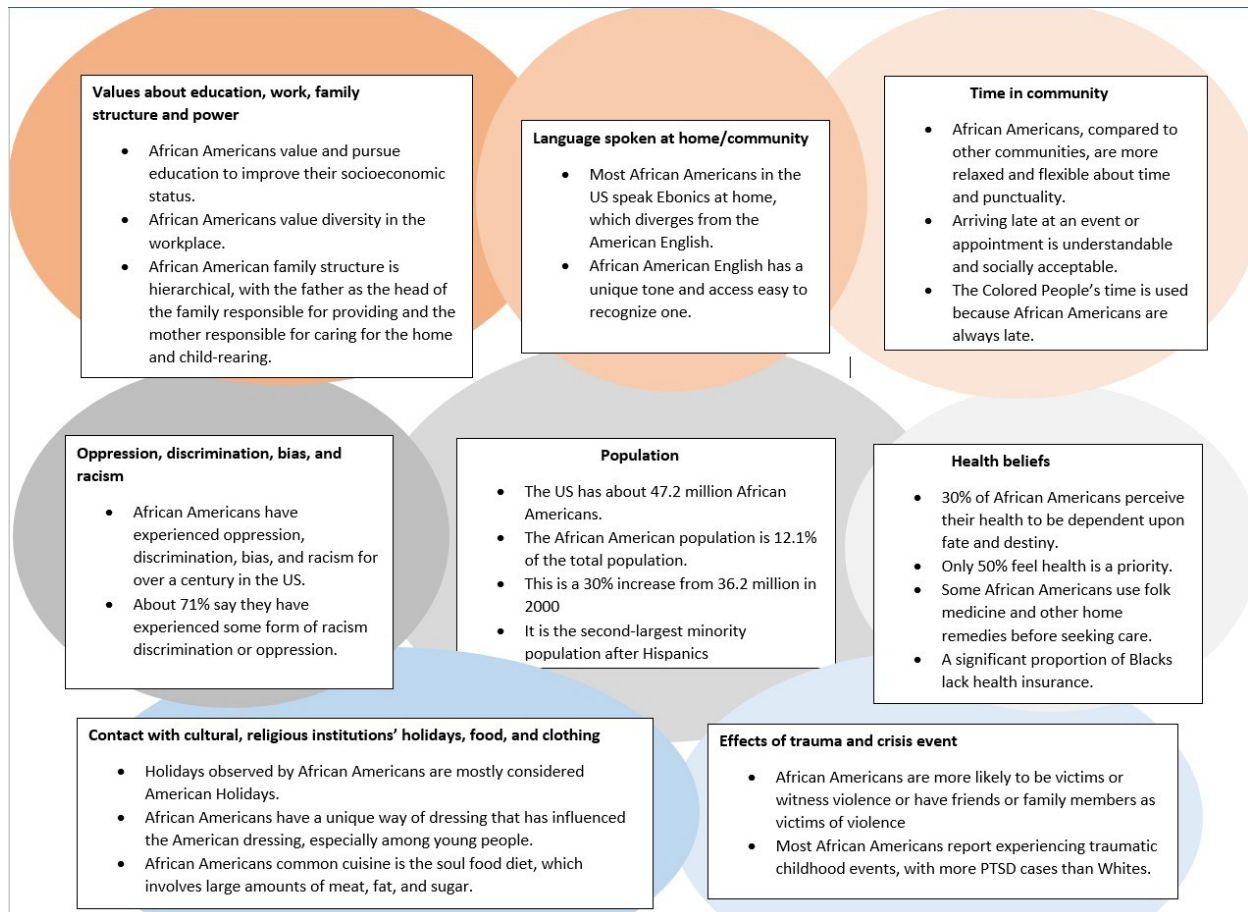

The African American community experiences multiple health disparities due to social determinants risk factors like poverty, menial or unstable employment, and cultural values that impact lifestyles.
